Requirements for Full-Time Police Officer:

- Must be a citizen of the United States
- Be between the ages of 21 and 45 years-of-age
- Currently certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
- Possess a valid Oklahoma Driver's License
- Possess a High School Diploma or GED
- Pass a background check and drug screening
- Must pass pre-employment screening
- Must pass written exam and/or oral board
- Pass or have current confirmation of recent MMPI Psychological Examination
- Must meet the requirements of the Oklahoma Police Pension Board
- Have the ability to work varied shifts/schedules, including weekends and holidays
- Live within 45 minutes of the department and able to respond to emergency re-call upon short-notice
- No convictions for Domestic Violence or associated restrictive court orders
- No felony or major misdemeanor convictions
- No pending criminal charges
- No alcohol or drug related charges related to driving convictions
