REMINDER - It is illegal to leave items unattended without staff present.

The Piedmont **FIRST SATURDAY** Recyclers will co-host another city wide cleanup on **SATURDAY, April 4th**. RECYCLING will be provided North of the Farmers Co-op located north of 164th Street/Washington Avenue on the west side of Piedmont Road. In addition to the usual "FIRST SATURDAY" activities, the recyclers *will accept all types of metals*. **The City of Piedmont has arranged for dumpsters to the SW of Co-Op on Saturday, April 4th only for LARGER trash items.**

**IT IS ILLEGAL TO LEAVE ITEMS BETWEEN BINS/TIRES WILL BE
ACCEPTED THIS TIME!**

RECYCLING NOTES:

ALWAYS CLEAN AND SORT ITEMS

PLASTIC BOTTLES – labeled 1 & 2 ONLY (soda bottles, milk, & juice jugs)

GLASS CONTAINERS— colors sorted (bottles & jars only)

ALUMINUM CANS – crush when possible

TIN CANS & METAL LIDS – rinse, labels okay – crush when possible

BROWN PAPER SACKS & MAGAZINES – *clean only*

(Can also be dropped off at the school bins and some churches in town)

NEWSPAPER – No plastic sacks, string, or cord in newspaper bin

OFFICE PAPER – white, colored, shredded, computer, glossy

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD – collapse (do not crush), UNWAXED, NO PIZZA BOXES

(Chipboard is accepted. Bin available 24 hours a day)

ALL FERROUS & NON FERROUS METAL – appliances, wheelbarrows, bicycles,
lawn mowers, anything metal

DUMPSTERS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE AT CO-OP DURING THIS WEEK

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR CURBSIDE PICK-UP:

BAG - heavy plastic sacks or bags of trash with a total weight not exceeding 35 pounds

BULKY - furniture and other large bulky waste items

GARBAGE & RUBBISH - all wood products, printed matter, paper, pasteboard, cardboard, rags, discarded clothing, shoes, and boots

YARD WASTE - all waste materials generated by a residential customer when clearing, mowing, edging, and maintaining a yard, garden, or other landscaped area to include tree trimmings, grass cuttings, dead plants, weeds, leaves, or branches. Please bundle branches and limbs.

BUNDLES - trash, tree limbs, shrubs, brush trimmings, newspapers, and magazines need to be securely tied together forming an easily handled package

ALL ITEMS LISTED ABOVE NEED TO BE IN A 4x4 AREA AND EACH BAG OR BUNDLE MUST BE 35 LBS OR LIGHTER

THESE ITEMS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:

NO CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS - Waste building materials resulting from construction, remodeling, repair, demolition operations, or roofing materials and shingles.

NO DEAD ANIMALS

NO STABLE MATTER

NO HAZARDOUS WASTE

NO OIL

NO METAL
